# Covid Protocols

- Masking will be required for students while inside, adult visitors and unvaccinated employees on campus
- Students do not have to wear a mask while at PE, recess, or while participating in outdoor activities on campus.
- Students should bring a mask from home
- Teachers who are fully vaccinated will choose if they will wear a mask
- Cleaning protocols will continue
- We will be reevaluating our policy on October 1, 2021

# Covid Protocols

- Hand washing stations and handwashing throughout the day
- Plexiglass dividers available
- Contact tracing for positive cases will continue
- October 1st-Boulware administration will revisit Covid protocols
- Covid protocols are subject to change based on CDC recommendations and local and state Health Department guidelines

# Parent Responsibilities

- Take your child's temperature prior to arriving at school.
- If your child has a fever, symptoms of illness of any kind the child should remain home and your doctor should be consulted.
- Report any positive Covid test results and any Covid exposures to school administrators immediately.
- Send your student with a water bottle labeled with their name.

# Uniform Policy

- Socks must be white or black. They can be ankle or regular length- no knee-high socks. Shoes must be white or black athletic shoes with laces. **No boots, sandals, high tops, flip flops, slip-ons, or colored shoes.**
- The ONLY sweatshirts that can be worn at school are navy sweatshirts with the Boulware logo. These can be purchased from Boulware for \$14.00 each. Jackets may be worn in cold weather but must be taken off when indoors.
- If a student comes to school out of uniform – meaning that any part of the uniform is incorrect – the following will happen:
- For out of uniform shoes or socks, the student will receive a warning. Additional violations result in lunch detention. Parent should be notified of warning and lunch detention for an out of uniform clothing piece, student is sent to the office to call parent to bring the correct piece or the school will give provide the clothing and bill the parents for the item

- Teacher's classroom are prepared for Monday. Please ensure that your child is supervised while in their classroom.

## Drop Off 7:15-7:40



- Students get dropped off between 7:15-7:40 and can get breakfast each day.
- Breakfast is served from 7:15-7:35 this year.
- Staff and/or Administration will monitor students in the cafeteria
- An adult will monitor parent drop-off and hand washing station at the gate.

Regular, timely attendance fosters student success.

Please have your child at school no later than 7:40.

# Pick Up



- Dismissal is at 3:00 (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)
- Dismissal on Wednesday is at 2:00
- We will be using the same procedure as last year.
- Please make sure whoever is picking up your child/children has the student's parent pick up card in their front windshield, so we can call for the students.



## Backpack Policy

- Students will not be allowed backpacks in the classrooms.
- Each student will be provided a canvas bag to carry school materials (take-home folder, lunch, library book).



# Parent Square

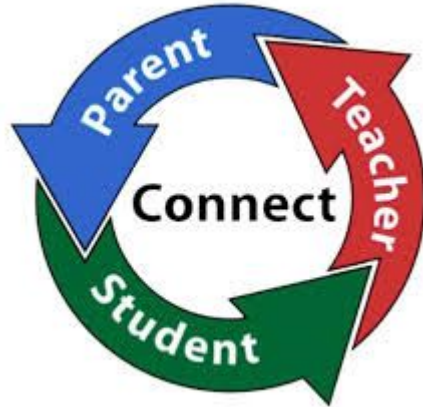
## Parent Square:

- Tuesday and Thursday; 3-5

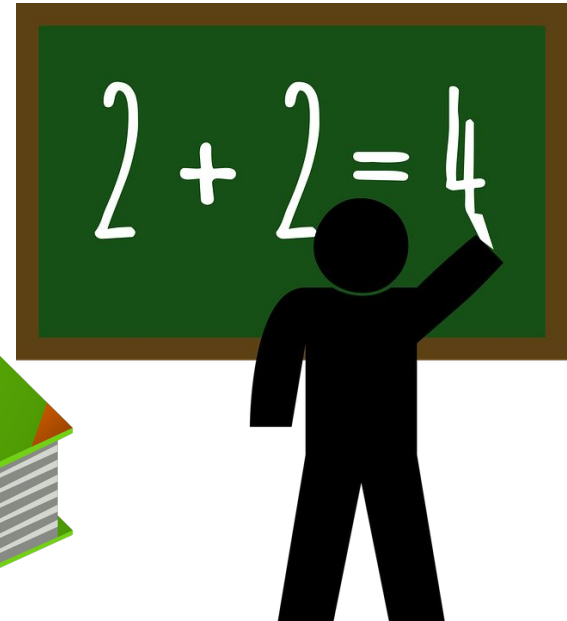
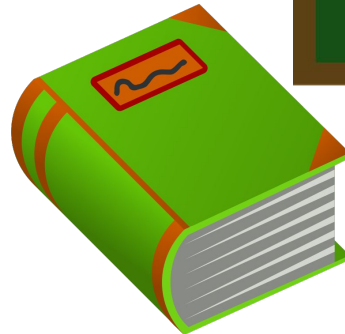
- **Chess**
